About the competition

The 2023 Northern Territory Languages competition is a free initiative by the Australian Council for Educational Research (ACER) in collaboration with the Language Teachers' Association of the Northern Territory. Through the 2023 competition ACER are seeking to contribute to the promotion of language learning in the Territory.

Students take part by sitting their relevant ALC language test during the competition period.

Eligibility

Available for Northern Territory students in years 7-12.

Languages Available

Chinese, French, German, Indonesian, Italian, Japanese, Modern Greek and Spanish.
